The Pan-hellenic Animal Welfare and Environmental Federation (PFPO) was established in 2010.

It is the largest animal welfare organization in Greece, bringing together **66 Member Organizations**.

Our mission is to protect animals and promote their welfare and rights through political lobbying, legal action, sciencebased positions and campaigning.




The **Panhellenic Steering Committee** was established in 2008 by the Animal Welfare Association of Chania (Creta).

It consists of 118 animal welfare organizations.


An interdisciplinary expert group of scientists and academics supports and coordinates the work of the Federation.




















As a member of ENDCAP/BFF, PFPO attends meetings in Brussels like the "Implementing the EU Action Plan against Wildlife Trafficking" and "Think Positive: Why Europe needs Positive Lists to regulate the sale and keeping of exotic animals".



We launch actions against the hobbling of farm animals (bulletins, investigations, filling charges, police and prosecutors' interventions). We secure the issuing of an Police Order on specific police actions and increased controls in the Cyclades.



PFPO brings the Animal Welfare debate at the Hellenic Parliament.



PFPO and the Central Union of Municipalities of Greece host the "Greece without strays: Requiring and developing a national action plan for animals" Conference, attended by MEPs, MPs, judges, prosecutors, police and veterinary officials and welfare organizations.

We launch actions on laboratory animals with the publication of our expert associates' research such as Cambridge's (prev. Harvard) biologist, Dr. Maria Iliou.



PFPO attends the "End The Cage Age" kickoff Conference. We actively campaign to reach the target of 80K signatures for Greece



We deliver a keynote at the Conference "The role and contribution of the Hellenic Police in animal protection" hosted by the Chief of the Hellenic Police.





PFPO launches actions against wild animals kept in zoos and dolfinariums. S.Eck, MEP has openly supported our efforts.



We are campaigning and lobbying against a new animal law severely compromising animal welfare. The bill is withdrawn in the midst of unprecedented public outcry.



PFPO and the Hellenic Society for Equine Welfare launch actions for the improvement of working equines' welfare, for controls and legislative enforcement.



We host the annual Conference of ENDCAP / Born Free Foundation.



PFPO, along with the regional police authorities and Bar Association host the Conference "Animal abuse: an antechamber to domestic violence", attended by prosecutors, psychologists, police officers and journalists.




PFPO and the Panhellenic Animal Welfare Federation have a meeting with the President of the Central Union of Municipalities of Greece.

## **Our focus**



### **EDUCATION**

PFPO is running the following educational programs for elementary and high school students:

- People & Animals: Roommates on the same planet
- People & Animals: Same right in life

Both are approved by the Ministry of Education and taught by accredited representatives of PFPO at schools all over Greece.



### **ENFORCEMENT**

PFPO is running workshops for police officials. The aim is to provide in depth understanding of the Animal Protection Legislation for better controls and enforcement.

PFPO has established relations with the police authorities across the country.



### **ACTION**

PFPO is at the frontline of animal protection.

Rescue missions, veterinary care, sterilization programs, adoptions, legal action in cases of abuse, campaigns and research are all core parts of our mission.







Hobbling - the practice of tying the legs of farm animals together - is widespread in rural areas. PFPO's on-spot checks together with the police authorities, legal action in cases of non-compliance and campaigning against hobbling capture media attention.



## Illegal breeding

Illegal trade of companion animals is growing. PFPO is monitoring online criminal networks in close cooperation with the police. Numerous prosecutions and the filling of charges follow our investigations.



### Dolphinariums

PFPO campaigns against dolphinariums and lobbies for legislative change. Coproducing a TV spot with Greek artists speaking against dolphins in captivity helps to raise visibility of the animal cruelty therein and discourage "educational" school visits.





### Fur farming

The city of Kastoria is a hub for fur farming and Greece is actively supporting the industry through subsidies and political backing. PFPO launches a campaign that brings on board brands and designers to speak openly about fur-free fashion.


